



Health Champion Award Nomination Process

- 1) September Initiate Champion Nomination Discussion

- 2) October Health Champion Nomination: Committee members completes and submits their nominations. The nomination form should include substantial information detailing the work and reason for nominating the individual/program/agency.

- 3) November Health Champion Nomination Selection: Each committee selects a final nominee. Congratulatory letters along with a personal phone call from committee chairperson are sent to the selected nominees. They are invited to attend a speak during the December Partnership for a Healthy Ventura County meeting.

Awardee Forms for each of the selected nominees are submitted by the committee chairperson. The chairperson from each committee is responsible for gathering the required information and submitting the form.

- 4) December Final Health Champion Nominee Introduction: The selected individuals/programs/organizations are introduced and recognized during the December meeting. They are also given an opportunity to speak about their work.

- 5) February Health Champion Awards: the selected nominees are recognized for their contribution in leading the to a healthy Ventura County and receive the Health Champion Award at the Board of Supervisors meeting in February, leading to the celebration and in honor of National Nutrition Month - which is in March.
